


UKRAINE IN MAJOR INTERNATIONAL ONLINE MEDIA

Media monitoring analysis

August 2023



Executive Summary

- The number of articles about Ukraine in major international online media in August 2023 decreased by 29% compared to July.
- There were 16K+ articles about Ukraine in major international online media with total reach of 293 mln contacts.
- German sources dominated in terms of the total number of articles about Ukraine due to large amount of duplicate publications.
- The largest daily number of articles about Ukraine was published on the Independence Day of Ukraine, coinciding with the second day after the death of Prigozhin, the leader of the "Wagner" PMC. Among other events that caused an increase in media attention to Ukraine were:
 - Landing of Ukrainian troops in Crimea
 - Russian warship firing warning shots at cargo ship in Black Sea
 - Drone & missile attack on Odesa
 - BRICS summit
 - Missile strike on a hotel in Zaporizhzhia
 - Dismissal of all regional military recruitment office commanders
 - Drone attack on Russian Black Sea Port of Novorossiysk
 - Liberation of Robotyne village
- The largest Ukraine-related topics in terms of the share of voice were:
 - ▶ The death of the leader of the Wagner PMC, Yevgeny Prigozhin – 15% of all articles
 - ▶ Ukraine's counteroffensive – 8% of all articles
 - ▶ Drone attacks in Russia – 8% of all articles
 - ▶ Shelling of the Ukrainian infrastructure – 6% of all articles

Methodology

- To create this report, we analysed **articles about Ukraine** published in the **biggest international online news media** during August 2023.
- The list of top media was defined **based on the audience size** of the source.
- The report covers **65 major media sources** for the following languages:
 - English (30 sources)
 - German (16 sources)
 - French (12 sources)
 - Spanish (7 sources)



Share of English, German, French, and Spanish articles among all publications about Ukraine in major online news media





Key topics about Ukraine in terms of the % of published articles



Share of voice is calculated as the % of articles dedicated to a particular topic among all the publications about Ukraine in 10 biggest news media (BBC, The New York Times, Daily Mail, The Guardian, Fox News, The Washington Post, New York Post, The Wall Street Journal, NPR, NBC News).

We believe the analysed sample of sources represents the general trends in major foreign media.

Number of articles citing Ukrainian or Russian public figures







Ukraine's counteroffensive

- In August, there was a clear positive trend in the tone of voice regarding Ukraine's counteroffensive.
- At the start of the month, most publications were concerned about the slow progress of the counteroffensive. Such words as "slow", "slow-moving", "slow-going", "slower than they would have liked", "slow and costly", "gruelling", "bloody, painstaking crawl", "brutal", "very difficult" were making the tone of voice. However, by the last week of August, journalists and experts started recognizing the Ukrainian army's breakthrough in the Zaporizhzhia region. Publication titles frequently featured phrases like "counter-offensive achieves breakthrough", "Ukraine gains on southern front could open way to Crimea", "Ukraine breaks Russian stronghold's first line of defence".
- During the first half of the month, there was widespread frustration in the media regarding Ukraine's approach to its counteroffensive. Both The Washington Post and The New York Times were at the forefront of this criticism. They specifically took issue with Ukraine's strategy, which involved deploying smaller units across various fronts instead of concentrating a larger force at a single breakthrough point, as recommended by the Pentagon. By the end of the month, a contrasting viewpoint began to emerge in the media: Ukraine's strategic approach was deemed sound, but it required additional time and resources, with an emphasis on increased support from its allies rather than unwarranted military assessments.
- In August, the media began to view attacks on the Russian Black Sea fleet and infrastructure as another facet of Ukraine's counteroffensive.

"Ukrainian forces have been fighting a brutal counteroffensive for the past two months, struggling to advance on land. Yet they have made progress on another front: the Black Sea, a vital shipping route for both sides of the war." (The New York Times)

Drone attacks in Russia

- Usually citing the President of Ukraine, media mostly viewed the drone attacks on Russian soil as the war coming back to Russia.

"Gradually, the war is returning to the territory of Russia — to its symbolic centers and military bases, and this is an inevitable, natural and absolutely fair process," Zelensky said. (Washington Post)

"Zelensky wants to show the Russian public the true reality of Putin's war." (Daily Mail)

- In the media, drone attacks are usually depicted as aligned with Ukraine's growing capability to strike over long distances.
- The main aims of these attacks are described as hampering the Kremlin's military logistics and raising morale of Ukrainians.
- It is generally believed that Kremlin will face difficulty in keeping the war distant from the Russian population as the attacks intensify.
- There is no consistent stance on condemning or justifying the attacks on Russia. Some authors express concerns about the potential escalation of the war, while others praise Kyiv's incremental approach, which has prevented a rapid massive retaliatory strike.

The death of the “Wagner” PMC’s leader, Yevgeny Prigozhin

- The topic that garnered the most foreign media attention in August focused on the event's impact on Russia and other global regions, rather than Ukraine.
- The most common messages regarding Prigozhin's death included:
 - Anticipated repercussions in regions where the Wagner Group had a presence
 - Concerns about an increased threat from the Wagner PMC if it comes under Putin's control
 - The event heightening a sense of instability among Russians.
- It was widely believed that Prigozhin's death was seen as Putin's retaliation following Wagner's brief rebellion.
